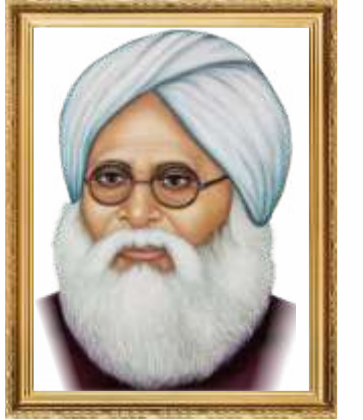

Eligibility

SSC-I : Matriculation PSEB/CBSE/ICSE/Any Other equivalent board

SSC-II : SSC-I passed from an institution affiliated to PSEB/CBSE/ Any other equivalent board

Documents Required at the Time of Admission

- Two recent passport-size photographs
- Aadhaar Card of the student and her parents
- Admit Card of the Previous Examination
- Detailed Marks Certificate (DMC) of the lower examination
- Transfer Certificate issued through the E-Punjab Portal, duly signed by the concerned school authority
- Official Category Certificate (SC) and Punjab Domicile Certificate
- Original Migration Certificate (applicable for ICSE/CBSE/other State Boards except Punjab)
- It is mandatory for students seeking admission to SSC II to submit a Transfer Certificate if they have passed SSC I from a school in another state

***Kindly carry the original documents along with two sets of photocopies of each.**

HMV Open School for Humanities and Commerce Group

The students who failed in 10+2 have been granted the opportunity for credit carry option for the pass subject in PSEB exam. The student needs to reappear only in the subjects which she has not qualified in the previous board examination. They will have to clear fifth subject of the group chosen within a year if passed the lower examination from National Open School, New Delhi; otherwise the provisional admission will be cancelled.

Rules For Leave

- Leave must be applied for on the prescribed form available at the HMV Tuck Shop/ General Office.
- Medical leave to be applied within three days of joining the school after getting it verified by the Doctor.

Rules For Attendance And Assessment

- Students must have minimum attendance of 75%.
- Appearing in House Tests is mandatory. In case of medical emergency, the students have to get their leave sanctioned as per rules.
- Monthly tests are conducted followed by two House Examinations, Term- 1 in September and Term- 2 in January.
