



### The Admission Procedure, Rules & Regulations

### The Academic Calendar 2025-26



#### Guidelines

- Admission begins on the very next day of the declaration of result of the previous class. However, to ensure the seats, the registration can be done even before the declaration of the result.
- Admission to all classes will be on merit and first-comefirst-serve basis.
- Each Student is required to create their ABCD ID on the online admission portal.
- Admission form should be signed by Parent/Guardian.
- Students seeking migration from other universities to GNDU will have to fill the eligibility form.
- Foreign students must secure a 'Student Visa' and fulfill requisite requirements of respective embassies; they will also have to produce the 'Recognition Letter' issued by Association of Indian universities, Kotla Marg, New Delhi.
- Admission to the college is subject to the approval of GNDU.
- Admission will be made as per the Reservation Policy.

#### **Documents at the time of Admission**

- Original Certificates and mark sheets
- Copy of the Adhaar Card
- Original Date of Birth Certificate
- Character certificate from the Head of Institution last attended. (for new students)
- Registration Card
- Official certificate of category like SC/BC and Punjab Domicile
- All the supporting certificates from competent authorities in case of SC/BC/ST and low income groups
- Original Migration & Eligibility Certificates
- Passport size photographs

### **Rules for Attendance & Examination**

- 75% attendance is mandatory according to the University norms.
- In case of shortage, the student will be detained.
- Appearing in house tests & scoring 25% marks in aggregate is mandatory. In case of medical emergency, the student has to get her leave sanctioned as per rules.
- Compliance of the requisite conditions of reservation/ scholarship is compulsory for availing benefits.

#### **Rules for Leave**

- Leave must be applied for on the prescribed form available at the College Utility Store/General Office and must be deposited in the General Office after verification from the concerned teacher.
- Medical leave to be applied within three days of joining the college.

#### **Code of Conduct**

The students

- must always carry their Identity Cards.
- should read Notice Boards daily.
- should make extensive use of the library.
- should be humble with the staff.
- should be polite to juniors and respectful to seniors.
- should maintain swachhata in the college.
- should park the vehicles at the appropriate parking space.
- should not deface college property.

**Note:** If a student absents herself from the college without leave for ten days continuously, her name will be struck off from the college rolls. She may be re-admitted on payment of Rs. 2000/- up to ten days and Rs. 5000/- up to thirty days at the sole discretion of the Principal.
